## Carbon Reduction Plan Statement

Portion Solutions Ltd are committed to advancing environmental sustainability by driving reductions in scope 1 and 2 and 3 Greenhouse gas emissions achieving Net Zero in accordance with UK Legislation.

Part of the Portion Pack Group we are aligned with Südzucker's Net Zero carbon emissions target of 2050, but strive to achieve it sooner.

- Scope 1 & 2 will be reduced by 50.4% by 2030 versus 2018 base line
- Scope 3 will be reduced by 30% by 2030
- 2050 Neutral

Further to this the importance of our Carbon Reduction plan (CRP) in the UK is recognised as been critical to the future impact and part to play for Portion Solutions in UK and other markets.

Portion Solutions Ltd CRP commitment and planned date of achievement (which will be by or before 2050), along with our base line footprint, detailing scopes 1, 2 and 3 and our % reduction targets for the next 5 years we aim to have concluded and published by Q1 2025

September 2023 saw Portion Solutions move from 2 manufacturing sites to one new purpose built modern site. This move itself will drive a benefit to the plan and will be a huge starting point in our forthcoming CR road map.

Alongside the site move we are also step changing and developing our CRP initiatives across the business, these include the below examples but are not limited to:

Factory & People: LED Lighting, installing (where feasible) energy efficient equipment, central warehousing, Electric car scheme, Recycling and Waste management, smart logistic decisions. Promotion and facilitation of increased working from home where possible, Sustainable options for Company cars (hybrid/ electric), Cycle plan. Reduced air travel

Product: Green Energy Procurement, Packaging and plastic usage in manufacturing materials , through launching industry first 100% recyclable product groups to our customer base.

Support: Already a member of WRAP and a signatory of the Plastics Pact , we also are focussed on becoming closer to other organisations that can aid our CRP.
